On February 21 st, the NKBA Southern California chapter was hosted by Ferguson Galleries, BRIZOFaucets, Steamist, DCS and Fisher & Paykel for a unique and personal Modernism Week experience. Ferguson Irvine's manager, Erica Lynn, welcomed us bright and early into her showroom to enjoy a delicious breakfast and central meeting spot to board the bus. Once aboard our huge chartered bus, Katey Carlson and Tammy Adams (BRIZO and Steamist) took over and entertained us with BRIZO Bingo and Mimosas! The lucky winners each received a stunning BRIZO kitchen faucet! Congrats to Deirdre Eagles (new member) and Kelly Arbollo, of Zieba Builders!

Our first stop was at The CAMP, in the heart of Palm Springs. Ferguson's Chris Patti provided us with an excellent overview of their product showcase in The CAMP. After a little exploring, we headed to the Desert Palisades, Chino Canyon Project. We toured two stunning projects, the O'Donnell House and the Beadle House. The houses were beautiful! The first was complete and allowed us to appreciate a fresh example of forward-thinking desert modernism. The second home invited us to experience a piece of history. The new "Beadle House," realized by local architect Lance O'Donnell in collaboration with the Beadle Archives and Beadle collaborators, was created based on never-before- built plans of a '70s Beadle design originally intended for Paradise Valley, Arizona. Located at the foot of the San Jacinto Mountains, the structure comprises a compact base with a second level that cantilevers 14 feet out in every direction. Expansive glass walls, frame stunning views of the surrounding desert landscape.

Our day wrapped up with a fabulous cuisine and tasty drinks served in a beautifully remodeled private Mid-Century home. The very talented 'Chef Jen' prepared our meals using Fisher & Paykel and DCS appliances. We were invited to tour the entire home.
