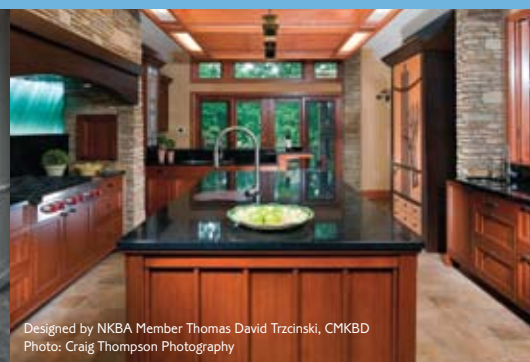

NOTE: Applications from students registered in programs not accredited by the NKBA cannot be processed unless accompanied by proof of current enrollment (transcript or letter from school official), in addition to the required membership dues.
