To avoid disqualification, please include the following materials with your Submittal:

- Completed Design Competition Entry & Photo Release Form with the Designer of Record and the owner/client signatures. Your name and company information may appear ONLY on the Entry & Photo Release Form.
- Floor Plans and Elevations* Submit per NKBA Guidelines and Drawing Standards identified with your NKBA member number only. Submit all drawings on standard 11 X 17 paper with your member number listed as the designer in the title block. Scale must be 1/2" = 1'-0"
- Design Statement* (200 minimum to 300 maximum words) describing challenges and solutions. Submit design statement identified by your NKBA member number only. Any identification of company or name will disqualify your entry.
- Photographs* submit in high quality photography (hard copies) as 8 X 10 or 8.5 X 11 size to show the final result. Before and after photos are encouraged.
- Digital CD/USB Drive: Place digital CD into a CD envelope with your member number on the outside of the envelope and on the CD. If using a USB Drive label with your member number. See attached page for checklist.
- Entry fee of \$150 for first entry. Entry fee of \$125 for each additional project entered. The fee will include contestant's entry into the design contest and one ticket for dinner at the awards gala. You may pay by check or credit card. Please make checks payable to NKBA Southern California. If you wish to pay by credit card, please fill out and return the Credit Card Authorization Form that is included in this entry packet.

*** All drawings, design statement, & photos must include NKBA member ID number. No names or company information will be accepted on any of these documents. For each additional entry, provide a separate and complete packet.**
